TICKETED ADMISSION GUIDELINES
AND COVID-19 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following information is intended to provide guidance on how we have to handle this year's Dog Dock Diving event with respect to registration, ticketed admission to the field and compliance with local and state regulations. We anticipate a significant interest and turnout this year and registrations could fill up quickly so do not wait to register at the last minute.

Please note that in addition to any other requirements as promulgated by The State of New York or County of Suffolk pertaining to COVID-19 restrictions, all rules and guidelines will be followed and enforced during the Dog Dock Diving Event at the Brewery.

REGISTRATION OF A DOG AND IT'S HANDLER:

1. You must pre-register on-line to participate in this year's event.
2. For each registration – 1 person (handler) will be admitted to the field at no charge for the three day period. (You will be given a wrist band to permit you to enter on the field for each day).
3. For each completed registration handler – you will be able to purchase up to 4 additional general admission wrist bands that are good for 1 day (\$10/pp and children under 5 are free). These additional wrist bands must be purchased on line through our EventBrite portal. 4. Be certain to bring your EventBrite receipt with you on the day of the event to confirm your registration and any general admission purchase.
5. Upon arrival at the event your registration will be confirmed at the gate and any additional wrist bands purchased on line will be issued at that time. (wrist bands for each day will be handed out on each day).
6. There will be NO WALK-UP TICKETS OR ON-SITE DOG REGISTRATIONS allowed.

COVID-19 RULES AND REGULATIONS:

7. In order to be admitted to the event (regardless of registration or not) you will be required to produce proof of full vaccination or a negative PCR COVID test within 72 hours of the date of your arrival and be subject to a temperature check.
8. You will not be permitted to enter the grounds if you are not feeling well or have a fever above 100° F.
9. You will be required to wear a mask when entering the property and moving about the grounds or entering any portion of the interior spaces.
10. You will be permitted to remove your mask once you establish your area of seating or standing provided you are 6 feet away from other attendees that are not with your group.
11. These rules and regulations are subject to change as updated by NYS under the NY Forward guidance.
12. Greenport Harbor Brewery reserves the right to refuse entry to or remove anyone from the field who refuses to comply with these rules and guidelines.
