

Camping is free to persons competing in Winery-hosted DockDogs events. In return, we ask that you support the Winery by stopping by the Wine Cave during your visit and making a purchase.

Permission (not notification) is required to camp (tent or RV) at the Winery. Please text Mark Malick at 540-270-3399 with details as to who, how many and when you will arrive and depart. No phone calls please. **Allow 24 hours for a response.**

Camping is boondocking/dry camping ONLY, i.e., **NO** services are provided: **NO** water, **NO** electric, **NO** sewer, **NO** garbage collection. **Absolutely NO dumping.** Portable toilets will be available at the competition site. **You may choose to bring a generator.**

There are bears in the area. For everyone's safety, **DO NOT** leave out food and/or trash overnight on the Winery property. Please plan to pack out ALL of your garbage. Prior to disembarking, please thoroughly check your camping area for trash. **Leave no trace.**

No fires are allowed in the grass. **A single fire pit will be provided for the group to use.**

For safety reasons, there is an area designated for RVs/campers and separate area for tent camping. **Please refer to the included map.**

4WD/AWD is highly recommended. There is a steep climb to the primary camping area. It is your responsibility to determine if your vehicle and trailer/camper has the necessary clearance to safely navigate the terrain. The Winery does not provide tow services. In the event of inclement weather, access to the camping area may be restricted to 4WD and AWD. In the event of inclement weather, there is an alternate camping location in the field adjacent to the outbuilding.

KOA in Harpers Ferry, WV (5 miles away) charges a \$20 tank dumping fee, which includes trash disposal in their dumpster. The campground store at the KOA in Harpers Ferry sells a selection of RV essentials and is open until 10 PM daily.

There is an Exxon located (3 miles away) at the corner of State Route 671 and US-340. The Exxon sells ice, gasoline, propane, and other essentials.
