Dog Activity Protocols & Procedures

Fairgrounds Rules:

- Owners must agree to, and sign, liability waiver agreement before receiving access to the San Diego County Fairgrounds.
- 2. Owners must bring proof of current vaccination record showing proof of up-to-date records of the following vaccines: Rabies, Distemper/Parvo, and Bordetella. Other vaccinations are optional but suggested.
- 3. Dogs must remain on a leash at all times, except when actively participating in a supervised and approved competition or activity.
- 4. Dogs must remain in Arena Complex or approved back parking areas at all times. No movement throughout other areas of the fairgrounds are permitted.
- 5. Dogs must not be left unattended at any time.
- 6. All participants, and their pets, must be respectful of other participants at all times.
- 7. Owners must provide access to fresh and drinkable water for their dog at all times while on the grounds.
- 8. Owners and handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their animals and disposing of all hair and feces in the proper waste receptacles.
- 9. The use of retractable leashes is prohibited.
- 10. Owners must always follow the instructions of San Diego County Fair staff and volunteers.
- 11. It must be understood that failure to follow these guidelines or poor behavior of any participants at any point in time can result in removal of owner and dog from the fairgrounds.


How to Access the Arena:

- From the 15 Freeway, travel West on Via de la Valle.
- Turn left onto Jimmy Durante Boulevard. You should make sure you are in the far right turn lane.
- After turning left, take an immediate right and enter the Stable Gate.
- Once you reach the guard station you will tell them you are with Dock Dogs and they will send you to a check-in station, where you will have to complete a waiver.
- By completing a waiver, you will receive a wristband that must be attached to the leash or collar of your dog for visibility of our security team showing you dog has received

clearance. You will also receive all necessary entrance credentials and parking passes. (see map)



After the check-in you will follow the map around the buildings to the parking area. Parking is limited, so we are asking groups to carpool, if possible, and to try not to bring oversized vehicles.



Once parked, please make sure the wristband is visible and on your dog's collar or leash, you can then enter the arena complex.
